Dear SBYC Member,

Welcome to the 2010 season!!! This week's weather makes it hard to believe it is already time to start thinking boating! And that means to get your slip requests and deposits in the mail. It is strongly recommended that you read By-Law #7, (SBYC Slip Assignments) so there will be no confusion at slip assignment time. **To be assigned a slip, you must be a member in good standing.** A member in good standing is defined as working at least one Tuesday night a month or the equivalent, working on at least one party committee a year and being free of club debt. If you have a problem meeting any of these requirements, please bring it to my attention so we can develop a plan for you.

Please read the rules and regulations governing dockage on the back of the slip request form. Boat owners must comply with these rules & regulations and any other reasonable rules and regulations adopted by the dock committee and approved by the board of directors for the efficient and safe operation of the marina.

**Summary of slip fees and procedures:**

- Power and sail boats at club docks - \$15.50 per foot
- Personal watercraft on floating docks - \$100.00 per season
- Boat or PWC on trailer on driveway - \$55.00 per season

**All slip requests are due by February 1<sup>st</sup>** and must include payment of 50% to be considered.

Assignment of slips will be made by March 1<sup>st</sup> with the balance of payment due by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Monies received by members for slips without assignments will be returned. No watercraft will be placed in their slips in the spring, until authorized by the Fleet Captain. All watercraft shall be removed before the Fall Dock Cleanup.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING DOCKAGE

In an effort to provide an inviting atmosphere for boat owners docking at the Club Marina, the following rules and regulations are provided for your protection. Your cooperation in observing the following rules will be appreciated.

1. When a boat enters Club docks, it immediately comes under the jurisdiction of the Fleet Captain. Boats entering the Marina will not create a wake that will cause discomfort to others and or damage to boats in the marina.
2. Pets shall be leashed whenever on SBYC docks. Pets permitted only if they do not disturb other guests. Pet owners will clean up after their pets.
3. Boats leaving for more than 48 hours will so notify the Fleet Captain. SBYC reserves the right to utilize all docks when vacant, however transients will move their boats as directed by the Fleet Captain.
4. Toilets and or holding tanks will not be flushed in the SBYC basin.
5. Refuse shall not be thrown overboard. Garbage shall be deposited in dumpster supplied for that purpose. No person shall discharge oil, spirits, inflammable liquid or oily bilges into the Club basin. Fires of any kind will not be permitted on the docks.
6. Fueling of boats from portable containers will not be permitted on the Club docks.
7. Noise shall be kept to a minimum at all times. Patrons shall use discretion in operating engines, generators, radios and television sets, so as not to create a nuisance or disturbance.
8. Keep dock areas clear of trip hazards, such as hoses, lines, power cords, etc. Bicycles, roller blades, and skateboards are prohibited on docks.
9. Swimming shall be confined to the designated swim areas.
10. Owner accepts the dock(s) in "as is" condition and agrees to maintain the same in safe usable condition. No alterations to the docks without the Fleet Captain's permission will be permitted.
- 11. Owners checking out of the Marina shall advise the Fleet Captain. All personal property must be removed from the Club docks when dockage rental is terminated.**
12. Visitors, or guests of boat owners shall park their vehicles in the outer parking lot.
13. Cooking and grilling fires are not permitted on the docks. Please use Club grills. Fires of any kind will not be permitted on the docks.
14. Violation of the above rules and regulations, disorder, depredations, or indecorous conduct by a member or his crew or guests that might injure a person, cause damage to property or harm the reputation of the Club shall be cause for immediate eviction from the Club docks of the boat in question.
